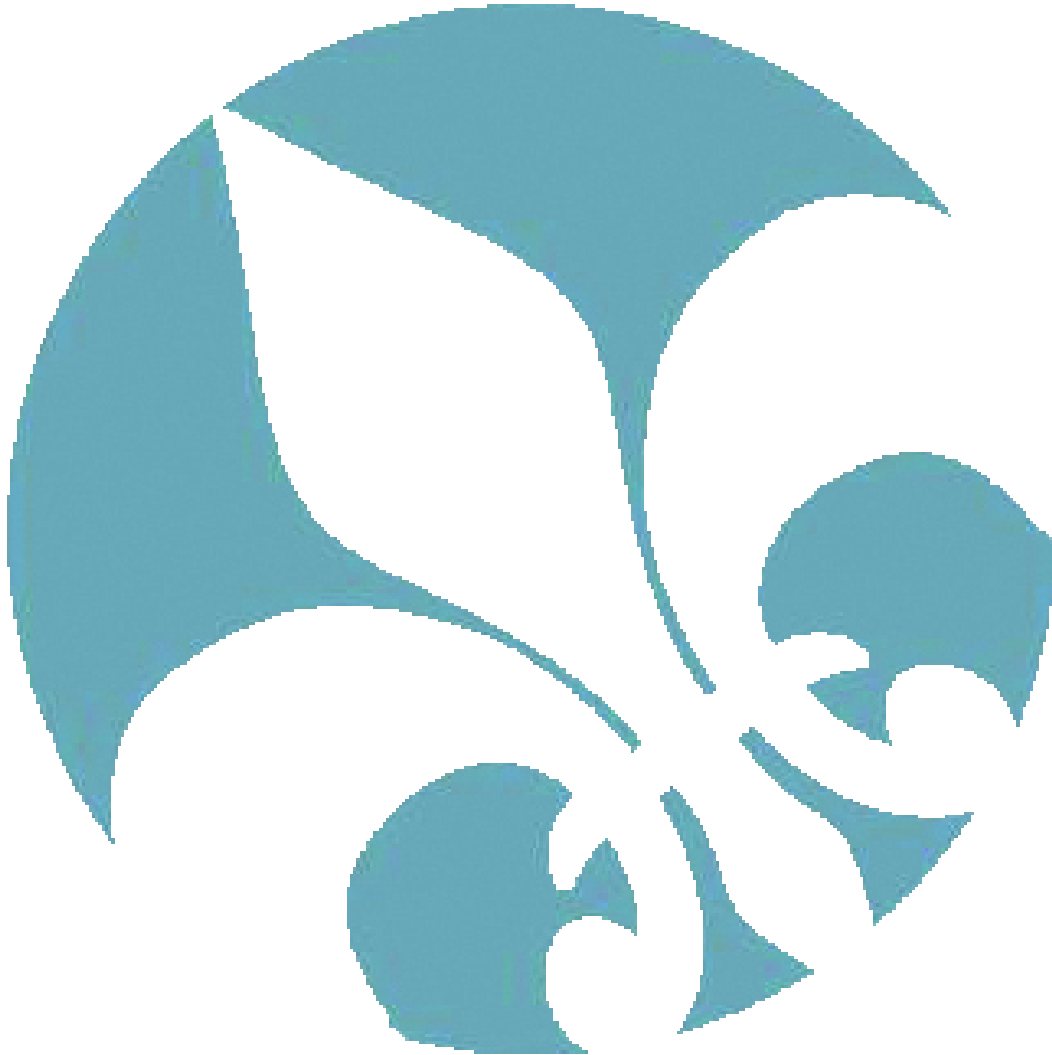

Scholarship Awards 2019

The purpose of the La Kish / Macy Memorial Scholarship Awards are to motivate and assist Greater Sacramento's lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer (LGBTQ) and other community ally students in pursuing and completing an educational degree or further study with small, but helpful, individual scholarships annually or bi-annually depending on available funds.

Eligibility

Applicants must reside in or plan to attend a university, college or vocational school in one of the following counties within CGNIE's territories: Alpine, Amador, Colusa, Del Norte, El Dorado, Glenn, Humboldt, Lassen, Mendocino, Modoc, Napa, Nevada, Placer, Plumas, Sacramento, Shasta, Sierra, Siskiyou, Solano, Sonoma, Sutter, Trinity, Yolo, and Yuba. The student must be enrolled in the 12th grade of high school or in a university, college, or a qualified vocational school, or intend to be so enrolled in September 2019. The student must submit a fully completed scholarship application. The student must have a minimum 3.0 cumulative grade point average. Applications that are not fully completed may be automatically disqualified from consideration.

Application Deadline

We will be awarding scholarships at Sacramento Rainbow Festival, September 1st, 2019. The completed application must be postmarked (if mailed) or transmitted electronically to CGNIE Board of Directors / Scholarship Director no later than August 12th, 2019.

Awards and Conditions

Scholarship recipients will be notified in writing on or before August 24th, 2019.

At least one [1] scholarship will be awarded, of no less than \$500 for the 2019 season. Awardees are strongly encouraged to attend Sacramento Rainbow Festival on Sunday, September 1st, 2019; in order to be formally introduced, presented with their scholarship award, and to make brief remarks if desired.

Scholarship recipients agree that CGNIE may post their photographs, names, goals and objectives on CGNIE's website. An applicant may, without any adverse impact on the consideration of his/her application, indicate in writing and accompanied by the application, that any award remain confidential. In such event, private arrangements for presentation of the award will be made and CGNIE will not place that recipient's information on CGNIE's website. However, CGNIE cannot further guarantee confidentiality.

Selection

Scholarship award decisions are made by the Scholarship Director of CGNIE's Board of Directors, Scholarship Committee. Finalists will be selected based on the following criteria:

- Academic achievement based on grade point average
- Life experiences and ambitions
- History of involvement with the LGBTQ community or in related issues and activities
- Quality of written expression
- Financial need or necessity
