SCHOLARSHIP SUMMER AWARD 2023

The Purpose of the LaKish / Larry Macy Scholarship Awards is to motivate and provide financial assistance to the lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer, questioning, intersex, and other individuals in our community (LGBTQI+) pursuing and completing an education or vocational degree. We do this to spark more diversity in the general work fields and so that more LGBTQ+ are represented and have access as an underrepresented community. Awards are made available twice a year and are based on available funds.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must reside in one of the following counties within CGNIE's territories: Alpine, Amador, Butte, Colusa, Del Norte, El Dorado, Glenn, Humboldt, Lake, Lassen, Mendocino, Modoc, Napa, Nevada, Placer, Plumas, Sacramento, San Joaquin, Shasta, Sierra, Siskiyou, Solano, Sonoma, Sutter, Tehama, Trinity, Yolo, and Yuba. The applicant must be a graduating high school senior or college/vocational student. The applicant must submit a fully completed scholarship application. The applicant must have a minimum 3.0 cumulative grade point average. Applications that are incomplete will not be considered.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

The completed applications must be postmarked (if mailed) or transmitted electronically via email to the CGNIE Board of Directors no later than August 25, 2023.

AWARDS AND CONDITIONS

Scholarship recipients will be notified in writing on or before August 30, 2023. At least one (1) scholarship will be given for no less than \$500 for 2023. Awardees are strongly encouraged to attend the Rainbow Festival on September 3, 2023, to be formally introduced and presented with their scholarship award.

Scholarship recipients agree that CGNIE may post photographs, names, goals, and objectives on CGNIE's website and local newspapers. Without any adverse impact on the consideration of his/her application, an applicant may indicate in writing and accompanied by the application that any award must remain confidential. In such an event, private arrangements for the presentation of the award will be made and CGNIE will not place that recipient's information on CGNIE's website or local newspapers. However, CGNIE cannot further guarantee confidentiality.

SELECTION

The CGNIE's Board of Directors makes the final scholarship award decisions. Finalists will be selected based on the following criteria:

- Academic achievement based on grade point average
- Life goals and future ambitions
- History of involvement with the LGBTQIA+ community or in related issues and activities
- Quality of written expression
- Financial need or necessity

CHECK DISBURSEMENT

The actual check will not be disbursed at the Check Presentation Ceremony. Award recipients must present the CGNIE Treasurer with proof of enrollment. Proof can be an acceptance letter to your attending college or a class schedule. Checks will be mailed to the home address on your application unless otherwise specified
